Remembering Norma

The Vantage community has lost a remarkable resident and tireless champion this summer. Norma Hoffman passed away in June, at the age of 91. She is widely remembered for her love of Huntley Meadows park and unflagging efforts to protect it from county development. She was also a vibrant presence at the annual Vantage picnic. There was always a crowd around her table, where she would tell everyone who stopped by about the wonders in the park and remind us all why it is so important to fight for this natural space we are so lucky to have right next door.

As described in her obituary, "her most lasting legacy was saving Huntley Meadows Park, a 1,500-acre wetlands oasis in Fairfax County. For 15 years, she fought county officials who were dead set to build a four-lane highway through the park. Norma assembled a team of 600 scientists, lawyers and concerned citizens and convinced the federal government to rescind the county's approval of the road. While forceful in battle, Norma never made an enemy. For her leadership, she received more than 30 county, state and national awards, including being named in 1992 as one of the Sierra Club's "100 Environmental Heroes" and as the Virginia Wildlife Federation's "Conservationist Of The Year." The park's visitors' center bears her name. She also co-founded Friends of Historic Huntley, which drove the preservation of the former mansion of George Mason's grandson, which now is on the National Register of Historic Places. Throughout her life, Norma was a beacon of good cheer, generosity and selflessness. A natural teacher, children flocked to her, even in a remote Amazon River village. Norma found beauty in the most mundane, such as the pattern in a hospital bay curtain most would not even notice. Nature fed her soul, as did a good belly laugh. And chocolate. Norma made fast friends during elevator rides, and was the first to come to the side of friends and family in need."

She will be sorely missed!
